Thank you for your letter of July 9, 2018, transmitting the above-referenced survey update. We have reviewed the documentation and note the association of the previously unidentified circa 1930 tenant house with RB0684, a 1925 Minimal Traditional style house surveyed in the Architectural Reconnaissance Survey of the Atlantic Coast Pipeline Project Corridor, Northampton, Halifax, Nash, Wilson, Johnston, Sampson, Cumberland, and Robeson Counties, North Carolina (2016).

Discovery of the additional structure does not affect the previous eligibility determination. We concur that the property, RB0684, remains ineligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places for the reasons outlined in the report.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.

Atlantic Coast Pipeline, LLC (Atlantic) is providing this information for your records. RB0684, a resource that was previously reported in the *Architectural Reconnaissance Survey of the Atlantic Coast Pipeline Project Corridor, Northampton, Halifax, Nash, Wilson, Johnston, Sampson, Cumberland, and Robeson Counties, North Carolina Report, a 1925* house, was deemed ineligible for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). SHPO concurred with this recommendation in letters dated October 20, 2015 and May 24, 2016. On May 7, 2018, an additional structure, a ca. 1930 presumed tenant house in poor condition was discovered on the property while conducting survey for the proposed Project. ERM architectural historians recommend RB0684 remain ineligible for listing on the NRHP.
