Thank you for your March 5, 2018 memorandum providing comments on the above-referenced report. In regards to the Davidson River Bridge (TV0422), we concur with your reasoning that the bridge is eligible under Criterion C as an excellent and intact example of the evolution of the multi-span tee beam bridge. The proposed National Register boundary is the footprint of the bridges.

We concur that the Robert E. Patton House (TV0423) is individually eligible under Criterion C and is a contributing resource to the Patton Houses Historic District (TV598). The proposed National Register boundary for the individually eligible Robert E. Patton House conforms to the parcel, PIN 8597-45-2811-00. We also concur that the Patton Houses Historic District is eligible under Criterion C with the boundary for the Patton Houses Historic District as described. We look forward to coordinating an effects assessment for these properties.
