Thank you for your June 13, 2018, memorandum asking that we clarify the status of Overhills (HT0173), a property determined eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places as a result of proposed undertakings by the US Army, Fort Bragg. As outlined in your memorandum, the property is no longer considered eligible for listing, due to the Army's actions that damaged and destroyed the characteristics that made the property historic. Mitigation for these adverse effects was completed by Fort Bragg. We will correct the status of Overhills in our GIS and other survey site databases.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.

Overhills (HT0173) status in relation to U-5933: Intersection

Improvements at NC 87/24 and SR 1117 (Nursery Road), PA 18-04-0004,

Harnett County

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is currently working on the above-referenced project to improve the intersection of NC 87/24 and SR 1117 (Nursery Road). The Determined Eligible and Study Listed Overhills Estate (HT0173) falls within the Area of Potential Effects. Through discussions with the program archaeologist/coordinator at Fort Bragg, Ms. Linda Carnes-Mcnaughton, it was determined that mitigation for its acquisition by Fort Bragg was completed, assessed, and accepted in 2009. She stated that site no longer possesses any integrity due to loss of buildings and landscape and the property is no longer eligible. A brief conversation during an effects meeting in May 2018 with you also confirmed that the site no longer possesses integrity. The property is no longer determined eligible as it appears on the HPOWEB GIS service, and this memorandum serves as documentation for the removal of this designation.
