Thank you for your April 7, 2014, memorandum concerning the above report. We are pleased that you have concurred with our determination that the **Riley Wall House (H1274) is eligible for listing** in the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C for Architecture. We have considered the boundary that you have recommended for the property – twenty (20) feet from the west, south and east walls of the house and across Bearwallow Mountain Road to twenty (20) feet from the west, north and east walls of the bankhouse on the north side of the road - and agree that the area provides an adequate setting for the historic buildings.
