Thank you for your June 18th memorandum offering comments on the above-referenced report.

The label of "not extant" on 24 Old Leicester Highway may have been an editing mistake, when within the Boundary Description and Justification on page 37, it notes that "the boundary excludes the circa 1920 one-story hipped-roofed dwelling at 24 Old Leicester Highway. Although immediately to the west of the district, it is significantly altered and has lost all integrity." We therefore propose that the boundary remain as-is.

We concur with the assessment that Redman's Hall (BN611) is not individually eligible for National Register listing but is still a contributing resource to the proposed Craggy Historic District.
