Thank you for your March 1, 2017, email informing us that the North Carolina Forest Service proposes to remove the fire lookout tower at the above address and revert the land on which it is located to the owner. We understand that the Forest Service is no longer using the site and would like to remove the tower prior to reversion.

While we most certainly regret the loss of the tower, an iconic structure in the coastal plain, it is not listed in the National Register of Historic Places and its removal not subject to any federal or state preservation law or regulation. We appreciate your notification and will note the removal of the fire lookout tower in our maps and files.
